A "square" is one square foot of bed. "1 per 4 squares" means one plant in a 2 x 2 foot block. Where a range is shown (2-4), the lower number gives bigger plants. Blueberries and raspberries are not square-foot crops; see the online chart for row spacing. Numbers follow the standard square foot gardening spacing (3, 4, 6 and 12 inches on center).
